

Migratory Regulation

Local regulations on immigration establish three types of residence: permanent, temporary and transitory. See chart with a list and a description of the main admission categories that can be applied for by a foreigner intending to make contacts, provide services or conduct business, trade, entrepreneurial or investment activities in Argentina.

To start a business in Argentina it is required to have a permanent or temporary residence. There are no restrictions with respect to the nationality of company directors but they need to provide an address in Argentina.

Foreign investors who wish to obtain a permanent residence have to prove that they have made a direct foreign investment on his own behalf, of at least (Argentinean pesos)\$ 100,000= / USD 33,000=

In the case of a deposit for the same amount they could get a residence for the term of one year.
